MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

EURECOM (SOPHIA ANTIPOLIS)

AND

ÉCOLE NATIONALE POLYTECHNIQUE (ALGIERS)

1. Parties.

The parties to this Agreement are

- École Nationale Polytechnique, 10 rue des Frères Oudek, 16200 El-Harrach Algiers, Algeria.
- EURECOM, Campus SophiaTech, 450 route des Chappes, 06410 Biot Sophia Antipolis,
 France

Purpose.

- 2.1 The broad objectives of this Agreement are to promote cooperation in teaching, research and service to the community through an international exchange of students, staff and knowledge.
- 2.2 Upon the mutual consent of the parties, including the relevant academic management units within the universities, and subject to the availability of funds, collaboration may be carried out in, but not necessarily limited to, any of the following activities:
 - Graduate student exchange.
 - Visits between universities by academic staff (faculty).
 - Visits between universities by technical and administrative staff.
 - Collaborative research and publication.
 - Joint organisation of special technical or administrative programs.
 - Co-operation in the development of education generally, including the potential for offering joint programs
- 2.3 Each specific project relating to these activities will require the signatures of both Directors in order to be implemented as part of this Agreement.

Whilst the purpose of this Agreement is to outline an academic and management framework between the two parties, designed to promote internationalisation in both institutions, the parties do not intend to be legally bound to each other, and this Agreement does not impose legal obligations on either party. The provisions stated in this MOU are statements of intent only. This is a non-binding agreement between the Parties.

3. Joint Managers, Administrative Officers and Working Parties.

- 3.1 The CEO of each party to this agreement will each appoint one person to act as the Joint Managers of this Agreement.
- 3.2 The Joint Managers may appoint Administrative Officers or Working Parties to manage the details of particular activities or programs.

4. Publicity and Advertising.

- 4.1 The parties agree that each may publish or advertise the existence and nature of activity under this Agreement, provided that the partner does not indicate in writing that a specific matter should remain confidential.
- 4.2 All marketing or publicity material produced by École Nationale Polytechnique, which refers to EURECOM, will be submitted to the Joint Manager at EURECOM, for approval before public distribution.
- 4.3 All marketing or publicity material produced by EURECOM which refers to École Nationale Polytechnique, will be submitted to the Joint Manager at École Nationale Polytechnique, for approval before public distribution.

5 No Agency Or Employer-Employee Relations

Nothing in this MOU shall be interpreted as creating a relationship of agency or of employeremployee between the parties, their employees or representatives.

6 Limitation of liability:

In no event shall either Party be liable to the other for any damages whatsoever including, without limitation, direct, indirect, speculative, incidental, special or consequential damages in connection with performance under this MOU.

7 Duration of Agreement.

- 6.1 This Agreement will be effective upon signature by the Directors or their delegates for a period of three years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for a new period of three years.
- 6.2 The Joint Managers may, by mutual agreement at any time, and subject to written ratification by the Directors, modify the activities or arrangements undertaken under this Agreement.
- 6.3 Either party may, on a six-months written notice, terminate the Agreement in advance of its normal expiration or request the renegotiation of its conditions. Under such circumstances, staff or students who have commenced an activity under the Agreement should be allowed to complete the activity, under the conditions applying when notice was given.
